Halloween Parade & Parties:

If parents want to the see the parade, you are welcome to go to the back field at 1:45 PM and watch your ghosts and goblins parade by. Classroom parties will begin soon after our return to the school. Only classroom party parents may enter the building after the parade for the classroom parties.

*If the weather is *not* permitting, the parade is cancelled. If the weather is questionable, a decision will be made and relayed via Infinite Campus to all families by noon that day. Let's hope for good weather!

Parking: Please park on Walters Road and walk to the field to watch the 1:45pm parade. Parking in the Wyland lots will be restricted that day.

Halloween costume restrictions: In accordance with HTSD School Board policy, any weapons or replicas are prohibited. In addition, please keep in mind that the students will be parading outdoors and around the building. Masks and head coverings must allow for good visibility.


