Important Transportation Information and AM Drop-Off and PM Pick-Up Procedures

Bus Riders

Transportation information, including bus stops and times, is available on the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

Car Riders

AM Drop-Off: If you will be driving your child to school in the morning, please enter through the Lawrence Avenue entrance. Drive down the hill, circle around the island along the sidewalk, and stop. An adult will be there to direct your child as they exit the car. Remain in your vehicle. Once your child is out of the car and safely on the sidewalk, please continue to circle around the island and exit the same way you came in.

Please stay in line and do not pull around other vehicles. Be alert and yield the right of way to oncoming school buses.

Note: If you arrive with your child after 8:45 am, you must park your car in one of the "Visitor" parking spaces in front of the school and accompany your child to the office to sign him or her in.

PM Pick-Up:

All Family vehicles must approach from the Ferguson Road end of Wyland Avenue. Buses and Vans will approach from the Mount Royal Blvd. direction.

On the first day of school, each family will receive a vehicle sign with the student name(s). This sign must be displayed in the front window of the vehicle. Students will be dismissed by Wyland staff to their family vehicle as the cars line up along the sidewalk. Please stay in line, remain in your vehicle, and follow the direction of the Wyland staff at the pick up area.

Guidelines for the contest:


- 1. Create a design that is $8\frac{1}{2}$ inches by $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches. This is the size of an $8\frac{1}{2}$ X 11 inch sheet of paper folded in half.
- 2. Design must be original.
- 3. Keep the theme narrowed to "winter" or "holiday" themes that are appropriate for everyone. (Religious or "Santa" topics should be avoided.)
- 4. Photographs are also acceptable.
- 5. Create the design keeping in mind that it will be scanned and printed on an offset press. Line drawings and simple designs that translate easily to a duplicated one or two-color format are best.
- 6. Please write your name, grade, "Wyland Elementary", "Mrs. Howe", and the material used on the BACK ONLY of the card. Also, students are to sign their names on the back, agreeing that the design is original.
- 7. Entries must be turned in to Mrs. Howe by November 7, 2022
- 8. The final selection will be made by Administration.
- 9. The winner will be recognized at the January Board of School Directors meeting! School board members and administration will use the winning card designs for holiday cards sent to friends of Hampton Township School District!
