

Wyland's Open House Basket Auction -March 21st and 23rd



Dear 4th and 5th Grade Families:

Each year, students in fourth and fifth grade are presented with a developmentally appropriate lesson in Human Growth and Development during science class. Part of this lesson includes a video presentation. In order to give you a sense of the content, information about each video is provided below. All of the videos are produced by Marsh Media. A script for each video is also available upon request. Students will be separated by gender to participate in the lesson designed for them.

4th Grade Boys: Whatsa Hygiene? This video is approximately 18 minutes long. The theme is the importance of being clean and taking personal responsibility for hygiene.

4th Grade Girls: *Just Around the Corner For Girls* This video is approximately 15 minutes long. The theme is preparing for the onset of puberty, including menstruation and the reproductive system, and the importance of self-confidence and maintaining good hygiene.

5th Grade Boys: *Growing Up! For Boys* This video is approximately 12 minutes long. The theme is reinforcing good hygiene habits and normalizing differences during the onset of puberty including discussion of the reproductive system. The video encourages boys to talk to an adult they trust if they have questions about the changes they experience.

5th Grade Girls: Growing Up! For Girls This video is approximately 15 minutes long. The theme is reinforcing good hygiene habits and normalizing differences during the onset of puberty, including discussion of menstruation and the reproductive system. The video encourages girls to talk to an adult they trust if they have questions about the changes they experience.

If you have questions about any of the content presented above please contact your child's science teacher, school nurse, or building principal. Human Growth and Development lessons will be scheduled by each science teacher in April or May.


