Important Transportation Information and AM Drop-Off and PM Pick-Up Procedures

Bus Riders

Transportation information, including bus stops and times, is available on the Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

Car Riders

AM Drop-Off: If you will be driving your child to school in the morning, please enter through the Lawrence Avenue entrance. Drive down the hill, circle around the island along the sidewalk, and stop. An adult will be there to direct your child as they exit the car. Remain in your vehicle. Once your child is out of the car and safely on the sidewalk, please continue to circle around the island and exit the same way you came in.

Please stay in line and do not pull around other vehicles. Be alert and yield the right of way to oncoming school buses.

Note: If you arrive with your child after 8:45 am, you must park your car in one of the "Visitor" parking spaces in front of the school and accompany your child to the office to sign him or her in.

PM Pick-Up:

All Family vehicles must approach from the Ferguson Road end of Wyland Avenue. Buses and Vans will approach from the Mount Royal Blvd. direction.

Students will be dismissed by Wyland staff to their family vehicle as the cars line up along the sidewalk. Please stay in line, remain in your vehicle, and follow the direction of the Wyland staff at the pick up area.


