#### **Class/Morning Meeting**

While many of the elementary homeroom teachers have always held a regular classroom meeting to welcome students, discuss the day's agenda etc., we are using this school year to work together and across buildings to learn about and share strategies and fun games and to follow a similar structure in an age-appropriate way in all K-5 classrooms.

Holding a Morning/Class Meeting is a great way to build community, set a positive tone, increase excitement about learning, and improve academic and social skills. Be sure to ask your child about their class meetings this year!

#### Important Transportation Information and AM Drop-Off and PM Pick-Up Procedures

We will assume your child will be riding their district-assigned transportation home at the end of the day unless we are otherwise notified. If your student will not be riding their assigned bus after school, please let the office know.

#### **Bus Riders**

Transportation information, including bus stops and times, will be available on the Infinite Campus Parent Portal by August 19.

#### **Car Riders**

**AM Drop-Off:** If you will be driving your child to school in the morning, please enter through the Lawrence Avenue entrance. Drive down the hill, circle around the island along the sidewalk, and stop. An adult will be there to direct your child as they exit the car. Remain in your vehicle. Once your child is out of the car and safely on the sidewalk, please continue to circle around the island and exit the same way you came in. Please stay in line and do not pull around other vehicles. Be alert and yield the right of way to oncoming school buses.

Note: If you arrive with your child after 8:45 am, you must park your car in one of the "Visitor" parking spaces in front of the school and accompany your child to the office to sign him or her in.

#### PM Pick-Up:

#### All Family vehicles must approach from the Ferguson Road end of Wyland Avenue.

On the first day of school, each family will receive a vehicle sign with the student name(s). This sign must be displayed in the front window of the vehicle. Students will be dismissed by Wyland staff to their family vehicle as the cars line up along the sidewalk. Please stay in line, remain in your vehicle, and follow the direction of the Wyland staff at the pick up area. It is important that everyone adheres to these procedures.

Buses and Vans will approach from the Mount Royal Blvd. direction.

#### Walkers

Students who are walked to school in the morning may be dropped off at the flagpole with the Wyland staff member or at the main front doors. At dismissal, the walkers will meet their family at the flagpole to be escorted home.



#### Why Odyssey of the Mind is Good for Students ...

Odyssey of the Mind provides an opportunity for students to learn creative problem-solving methods while having fun in the process. By tapping into creativity, and through encouraging imaginative paths to problem-solving, students learn skills that will provide them with the ability to solve problems -- great and small -- for a lifetime. Odyssey of the Mind teaches students how to think divergently by providing open-ended problems that appeal to a wide range of interests. Students learn how to identify challenges and think creatively to solve those problems. They are free to express their ideas and suggestions without fear of criticism. The creative problem-solving process rewards thinking "outside of the box."

#### In Odyssey of the Mind ...

- Students develop team-building skills by working in groups of as many as seven students per team.
- Students learn to examine problems and to identify the real challenge without limiting the possible solutions and their potential success.
- The creative thinking process is nurtured and developed as a problem-solving tool.
- Students of all types will find something that will appeal to them.

Dear HTSD Families,

Hampton Township Odyssey of the Mind would like to invite interested students to register to participate in an <u>Odyssey of the Mind</u> team-based problem-solving activity. Odyssey of the Mind teams work together to creatively solve spontaneous verbal and hands-on challenges as well as a team-selected long-term problem that they will solve over the course of several months (until the regional tournament in early March 2023). Participants learn team-building skills and develop their own talents and creative thinking skills to present a unique solution to a posed problem. Teams of up to 7 students will be organized by grade (K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12) and meetings will be scheduled based on the coaches' availability. The time commitment is September through early March (or through May if teams advance to states and worlds), with one- to two-hour meetings at least two times a month (times to be set by the coaches),

For teams participating in person, the Regional Tournament date is TBD March 2023 (usually the first Saturday in March) and teams who advance may have possible trips to the State Tournament and Worlds Tournament in April and May respectively. For students who prefer a virtual setting, Odyssey of the Mind offers a virtual tournament, date TBD. The tournament schedule will be posted on <u>www.wpaodyssey.org</u>. You are encouraged to look at the Odyssey of the Mind website for more valuable information (<u>www.odysseyofthemind.com</u>) and look over this year's problem synopses with your child to decide if this is something they might want to participate in. K-2 students have the option of participating in the Primary Division problem, which is a non-competitive division that does their performance at the regional tournament without advancing to the state or world tournaments.

We can have as many teams as we have parent volunteer coaches. Parents who volunteer to coach will be guaranteed their child's spot on a team. After that, if we do not have enough coaches per student ratio, a lottery will be held to determine the remaining team members. Because Odyssey of the Mind usually has a coaches' training scheduled for the first Saturday in November, we need to form teams and begin meeting as soon as possible. I will hold a brief coaches' training for new and returning district coaches before team meetings begin in the last couple of weeks of September. **Please fill out the sign-up form online by Thursday, September 15 to sign up to participate this year. No money is due at sign-up.** The Hampton Township Odyssey of the Mind Association works hard each year to make sure any Hampton student who wants to participate in the program may do so with little to no cost, thanks in a large part due to corporate sponsorships, individual contributions, community fundraisers, and PTO support. There may be travel costs for families of teams advancing to state or world tournaments.
