For this issue of The Week @ Wyland we want to spotlight the Holiday Shop that is next Thursday and Friday. We reached out to the Committee Chairs, Laura Moser and Rachael Mazzoni, to give us the scoop.

PTO: Can you tell us a little bit about the Holiday Shop?

Laura & Rachael: Holiday Shop is a culmination of a full year of work from dedicated Wyland bargain shoppers. We mostly use our budget to buy goods on clearance after the holidays, but we do keep an eye out year-round for sales and deals. The kids are really excited to browse and shop for nice items at a great price.

PTO: What is the price point of the items?

Laura & Rachael: Tables are marked from \$1 to \$10. Many families new to Wyland may think \$10 seems like a lot to spend on a gift, but many of the items will have had an original retail value of \$20 and up!

PTO: What will my child's shopping day look like?

Laura & Rachael: During the actual shopping days, our parent volunteers are invaluable! Each parent is a personal shopper accompanying each child. A "budget" sheet is sent home with everyone, so the shoppers can help students stay within budget and buy appropriate items for the person listed. Then a couple of gifts are wrapped before sending home.

PTO: What a great insight into Holiday Shop. Do you have any final thoughts to leave us with?

Laura & Rachael: It's a lot of work, but a favorite event for many of the kids and parents. New shoppers are always welcomed, so if you have an eye for bargains, please reach out to us to join the fun!
