Sign ups close on Friday, October 21st! Every student involved must also submit a parent permission form, which will be provided soon.

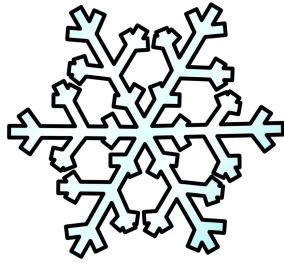

## Guidelines for the contest:

1. Create a design that is 8 ½ inches by 5 ½ inches. This is the size of an 8 ½ X 11 inch sheet of paper folded in half.
2. Design must be original.
3. Keep the theme narrowed to “winter” or “holiday” themes that are appropriate for everyone. (Religious or “Santa” topics should be avoided.)
4. Photographs are also acceptable.
5. Create the design keeping in mind that it will be scanned and printed on an offset press. Line drawings and simple designs that translate easily to a duplicated one or two-color format are best.
6. Please write your name, grade, “Wyland Elementary”, “Mrs. Howe”, and the material used on the BACK ONLY of the card. Also, students are to sign their names on the back, agreeing that the design is original.
7. Entries must be turned in to Mrs. Howe by November 7, 2022
8. The final selection will be made by Administration.
9. The winner will be recognized at the January Board of School Directors meeting! School board members and administration will use the winning card designs for holiday cards sent to friends of Hampton Township School District!

Hampton Township School District is committed to its students' success. Our goal is to provide a foundation that leads to happy, healthy, safe, engaged, and challenged students, ensuring they are well equipped to pursue and achieve their goals.

With a continued commitment to addressing possible barriers to learning, the District is implementing the Pupil Attitudes to Self and School (PASS) survey in two grades in each building (Central- Grades 4 & 5; Poff- Grades 2 & 5; Wyland- Grades 2 & 5; HMS- Grades 7 & 8; and HHS- Grades 9 & 10).

The PASS survey will help school teams identify reluctant learners who are affected by factors such as a lack of confidence, motivation, or connection to school. Developed by a team of educational psychologists from multiple universities, PASS provides teachers with reliable and valid information about how students feel about themselves as learners and how they feel about school. During the coming year, the PASS will be administered in the Fall and Spring. Please be assured that we will strictly protect student confidentiality.
