Dear 4th and 5th Grade Families:

Each year, students in fourth and fifth grade are presented with a developmentally appropriate lesson in Human Growth and Development during science class. Part of this lesson includes a video presentation. In order to give you a sense of the content, information about each video is provided below. All of the videos are produced by Marsh Media. A script for each video is also available upon request. Students will be separated by gender to participate in the lesson designed for them.

4th Grade Boys: *Whatsa Hygiene?* This video is approximately 18 minutes long. The theme is the importance of being clean and taking personal responsibility for hygiene.

4th Grade Girls: *Just Around the Corner For Girls* This video is approximately 15 minutes long. The theme is preparing for the onset of puberty, including menstruation and the reproductive system, and the importance of self-confidence and maintaining good hygiene.

5th Grade Boys: *Growing Up! For Boys* This video is approximately 12 minutes long. The theme is reinforcing good hygiene habits and normalizing differences during the onset of puberty including discussion of the reproductive system. The video encourages boys to talk to an adult they trust if they have questions about the changes they experience.

5th Grade Girls: *Growing Up! For Girls* This video is approximately 15 minutes long. The theme is reinforcing good hygiene habits and normalizing differences during the onset of puberty, including discussion of menstruation and the reproductive system. The video encourages girls to talk to an adult they trust if they have questions about the changes they experience.

If you have questions about any of the content presented above please contact your child's science teacher, school nurse, or building principal. Human Growth and Development lessons will be scheduled by each science teacher in April or May.

Dear Hampton Elementary School Families:

Please pass the word along to your friends and family – 2023 Kindergarten registration has begun!

Information regarding Kindergarten registration will be published in the local paper and placed on the HTSD Website (www.ht-sd.org). In the meantime, please spread the word to neighbors who may be new in the community or to those without children currently enrolled in the Hampton Elementary Schools. Registering on time is important so that the District can plan appropriately for the number of students who will be attending school in the fall.

Registration for Kindergarten and any first-grade students new to Hampton Schools will take place virtually. To register, please access the HTSD website www.ht-sd.org. Within the District tab, click the "About" Tab. Access the "Moving to Hampton" tab. Once there, families will find instructions for 2023 Kindergarten registrations under "Register My Child." Upload completed packets and documentation to the appropriate elementary school.

All families are encouraged to complete the online registration process by February 3rd.

Children ready to enter Kindergarten should be five years old by August 15, 2023. First graders should be six years old by August 15, 2023. A birth certificate or other acceptable evidence of birth and proof of Hampton residency (closing papers, lease agreement, rent receipt or residency form AND utility bill, cable bill, paid wage tax receipt, driver's license, guardianship form, or court order) are necessary before children can be enrolled. Proof of immunization is necessary as well.

Parents of children who do not meet the above-mentioned age requirements must submit a written request for early admission to the building principal by April 15, 2023. This request should state reasons why early admission to school is appropriate for the child, including information and test data from the school(s) he or she may have attended previously. Admission will be based upon the recommendation of the school in which the student seeks enrollment and the authorization of the Principal and Superintendent.
